- References listed in the last column are mainly for classification but they don't necessarily discuss classification.
-) that follows a group name means that it is not certain whether the language/dialect name that follows is actually a language/dialect name or not. But, if it is a language/dialect name, it probably belongs to this group. For example, Anson Bay) R2 Bathamal
It is not certain whether Bathamal is actually a distinct language/dialect name, but if it is so it probably belongs to the Daly, Anson Bay group.
- ? that follows a group name means that the language name that follows is most likely a language/dialect name but it is not certain whether it belongs to this group. For example, Western Daly, N159 Gonbudj
Gonbudj is most likely a language/dialect name, but it is not certain whether it belongs to the Daly, Western Daly group.
- * in front of reference names mean that there is data which can be studied (although often it is very little). AIATSIS is particularly interested in research in these languages/dialects, the Paman (or Pama-Maric) group and the Yolngu group. We are also interested in research on the Durubulic group and the Nyawaygic group and their relationships to the surrounding groups.
